

Information and maintenance instructions for wood surfaces – Handling and maintenance of parts made of oiled solid wood surfaces –

1 GENERAL

Wood is a natural and very popular material, that contributes to a warm and comfortable atmosphere in the interior area. To keep the natural beauty of your new oiled solid wood surface over years, to keep the natural warm brightness, and to avoid, that fluids could make damage, you should clean all surfaces regularly. The right care guarantees a long lifetime of the surface.

2 PRE-REQUISITES

Please adhere to the following requirements in order to achieve a long-lasting durability of your new wood surface

- Keep the surfaces clean. Avoid residues of foodstuffs, spices and cleaning agents;
- Ensure that the surfaces remain undamaged. Avoid damage while cleaning or during use or repairs that may be caused by sharp-edged objects;
- Always remove soiling and spilled fluids (for example beverages) immediately, so that it can't soak;
- Acids of all types (e. g. juices, wine, carbon dioxide, acidic cleaning agents) corrode the surface;
- Don't use acid or alkaline cleaning agents.

3 CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

Appropriate maintenance is another important step for achieving a long-lasting durability of your marble and travertine. Please read the following cleaning and maintenance instructions carefully:

3.2 REGULAR MAINTENANCE

3.2.1 DRY CLEANING

Remove bulk dirt with fine duster.

3.2.2 MOIST CLEANING

For the moist cleaning we recommend HANTON care set nr. 2 (Pflegeset No. 2) for the interior area. When you have low dirt, use cleaner (Reiniger), with water diluted 1:100 (100 ml cleaner to 10 litre water), only to mop moistly, not too wet. The surface is getting cleaned and maintained in one step.

When you have more dirt, and for more intensive maintenance, make higher dosing, maximum 1:10 (100 ml cleaner to 1 litre water).

The cleaner is good for removing water soluble dirt and maintains with natural Carnauba-wax.

The cleaner can be used for all furniture surfaces and floors, that are handled with natural products and varnish. Not to be used on mirrors, marble or slippery surfaces.

NOTE | Never let fluids soak on the surface.

3.2 REFRESHMENT

Put the liquid wax (Flüssigwachs) on a cloth and apply lightly on the surface (not too much). At this time the furniture shall be clean and dry. Then polish up. The liquid wax is applicable universally.
